California Wild Lilac

(*Ceanothus* species)

Cultivars:

'Yankee Point'
'Concha'
'Skylark'

Attracts butterflies and supports insects that insectivorous birds feed on.

Provides good nesting sites, and acorns for birds and mammals.

(shrubby *Mimulus* species)

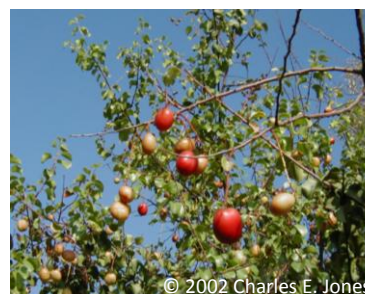
Other *Mimulus* species:
