

**Here's some basic instructions for flyer delivery.
Thank you once again for your help.**

Note: Unless otherwise arranged with the coordinator, go two by two with one person on each side of the street always staying within sight of each other.

- 1) DO NOT GO THRU GATES. There may be a dog on the other side. Attach flyer to the fence.**
- 2) We are not allowed to put flyers in, OR attach flyers to any part of a mailbox.**
- 3) Look to put the flyer under a doormat on the front steps, (preferably under an eave in case it looks like rains.**
- 4) Leave the part that says "Join Us! FREE Guided Tour of _SWAN___ Canyon/Creek" showing so that it can be read while being picked up.**
- 5) If there is a gate, don't go through, but roll the flyer into a loose tube with "Join Us! FREE Guided Tour of _____" showing, and wedge it between the fence slats or the post and the gate.**
- 6) If you see someone along the way, in their front yard for instance, invite them to come. "Hello, We're having a FREE guided tour of __SWAN CANYON on Saturday __Feb. 21_____, We're going to talk about the habitats, the wildlife, the endangered species etc. I hope you can make it. We're trying to build a friends group for __SWAN____ Canyon.**
- 7) Highlight the streets that you cover so that we'll know which ones still need to be covered. We'll pick up the map when you're done, usually meeting at a designated spot and time.**
